


ACTIVITY BOOKLET: Answer Key

These two helmets are in the display case in the Visitors' Lounge.


One is old and the other is new.

In the exhibit, find the pair of photos called CAMARADERIE.



Which photo shows the soldiers seated?





Carrier pigeons provide what kind of service to military personnel?


They transport secret messages.
